ESTATE TC143 – Roseleigh, Pollrone, Mooncoin, Co. Kilkenny

In accordance with the decision of the Council on 19th of July 2021, a notice was published stating that Kilkenny County Council proposed to declare the road in the schedule hereunder to be a public road in accordance with the provisions of Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993 in order to facilitate the taking in charge of the estate in accordance with Section 180 of the Planning & Development Act 2000, as amended by Section 59 of the Planning & Development Act 2010.

Written representations or objections in relation to the taking in charge were invited from the public, however none were received. Works to bring the development to a standard suitable for taking in charge have been completed. In addition, the road is considered to be of a public utility. There are little or no financial implications in taking this estate in charge. Water services assets will be taken in charge by Irish Water upon conclusion of its protocol process.

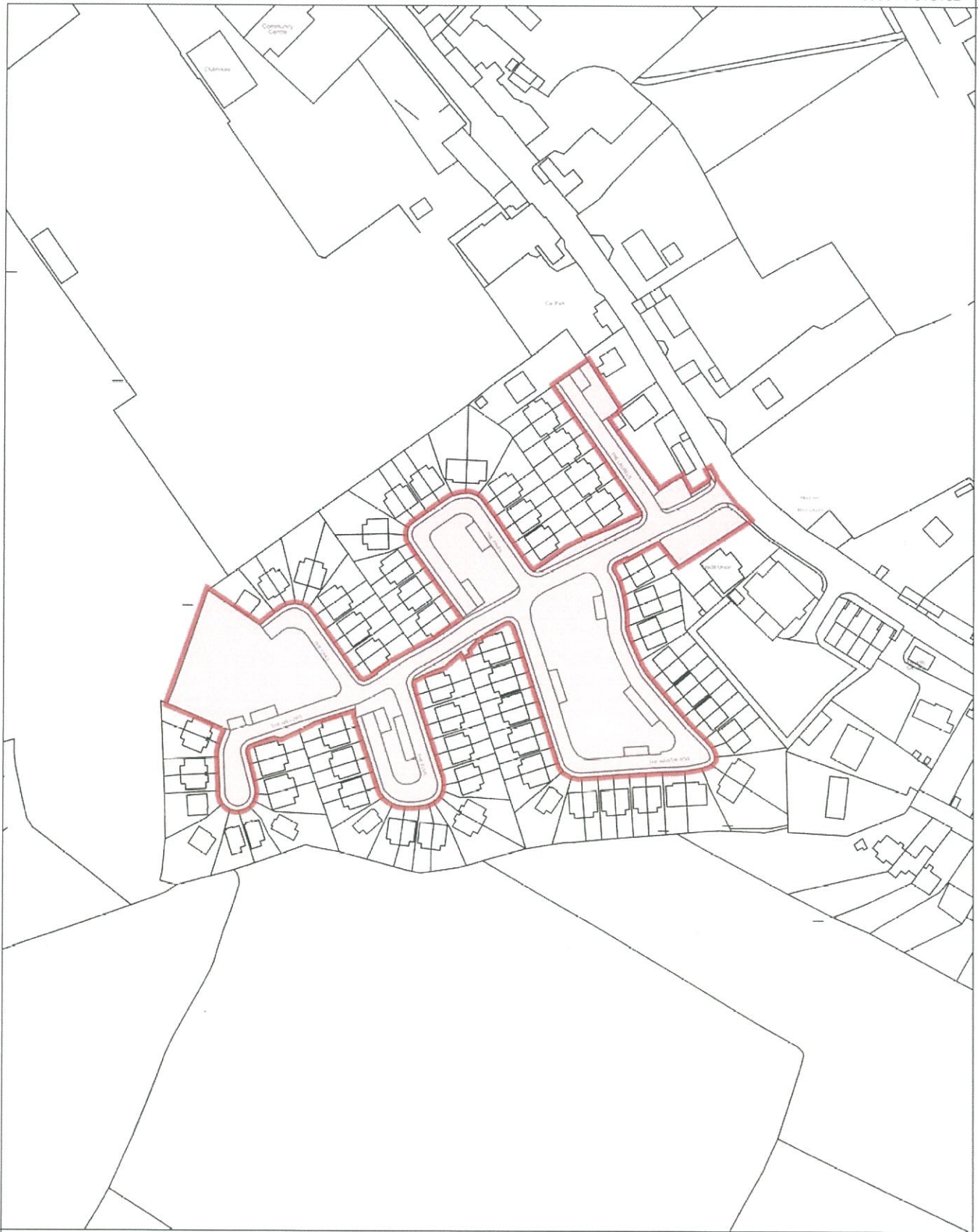
